**RE: CRANKSHAFT SENSORS** 

To all Club Members and Associates,

Following a query regarding sensors - specifically Crankshaft Sensors - and after consultations with both the M7RC's MSA Eligibility Scrutineer and Technical Commissioner, the Committee of the Mini Seven Racing Club issues the following clarification:

M7RC 2013 Regulations, Engine section TR.5.7, under sub-section TR.5.7.1.7 (xix) - Mini Se7en only, and under sub-section TR.5.7.1.8 (xii) - Mini Miglia only, the wording for both is "Ignition systems are free. However it is forbidden to add additional sensors (i.e. temperature, airflow, etc) or throttle potentiometers, this includes vacuum feeds."

The intention of this wording is to allow for one single sensor on the ignition system, which may be a Crankshaft Sensor, but that no other sensors on the ignition system are permitted.
